

PRIVACY POLICY

Cookies

1. The Service does not automatically collect any information, except for information contained in cookies.
2. Cookies are IT data, in particular text files, which are stored on the User's end device and are intended for use on the Service's websites. Cookies usually contain the name of the website from which they originate, the time they are stored on the end device, and a unique number.
3. The entity placing cookies on the User's end device and accessing them is the operator of the Service - Fundacja Świadomej Nauki.
4. Cookies are used for the following purposes:
 - a) adapting the content of the Service's websites to the User's preferences and optimising the use of the websites; in particular, these files allow the User's device to be recognised and the website to be displayed accordingly, tailored to the User's individual needs;
 - b) creating statistics that help to understand how Users of the Service use the websites, which enables improvements to their structure and content;
 - c) maintaining the User's session (after logging in), thanks to which the User does not have to re-enter their login and password on each subpage of the Service.
5. Within the Service, two basic types of cookies are used: "session" cookies and "persistent" cookies. Session cookies are temporary files stored on the User's end device until logging out, leaving the website, or switching off the software (web browser). Persistent cookies are stored on the User's end device for the time specified in the cookie parameters or until they are deleted by the User.
6. The Service uses the following types of cookies:
 - a) "necessary" cookies, enabling the use of services available within the Service, e.g. authentication cookies used for services requiring authentication within the Service;
 - b) cookies used to ensure security, e.g. to detect misuse in the field of authentication within the Service;
 - c) "performance" cookies, enabling the collection of information on how the Service's websites are used;
 - d) "functional" cookies, enabling the "remembering" of settings selected by the User and personalisation of the User interface, e.g. in terms of the chosen language or region of the User, font size, website appearance, etc.

7. In many cases, software used for browsing websites (web browser) by default allows cookies to be stored on the User's end device. Users of the Service may change their cookie settings at any time. These settings may be changed in particular to block the automatic handling of cookies in the web browser settings or to notify the User each time cookies are placed on their device. Detailed information on the possibilities and methods of handling cookies is available in the software settings (web browser).
8. Fundacja Świadomej Nauki informs that restrictions on the use of cookies may affect some of the functionalities available on the Service's websites.
